

Deciphering Mammi Dev code is his singular passion

THERE would be a world war in 2075 — a high-tech sky war — in which the sky and earth would vibrate to such an extent that the earth's axis would change resulting in no more eclipses thereafter.

Only time will judge the truth but as of now, this is the prophecy of Kurch's very own Mammi Dev, 89-year-old retired engineer and executive editor of a magazine, *The Matriarch*.

This sect in the 14th century, predicted precisely what was going to happen in the following centuries up to the present day.

Mammi has taken the initiative

of explaining Mammi Dev's predictions in simple language in his book and has also come up with a website. So was the seer another Nostradamus?

"What Mammi whom we followers of Kurch, Sanskrita believe to be incarnations of Brahma, the creator of the universe, said 600 years ago was later corroborated by Nostradamus," Mammi says.

Nostradamus had said that God will descend on that part of the

the big war in 2075," Mammi said.

Mammi said his predictions included rise and fall of Mughal empire, independence of British India, democracy, rise of terrorism and World War III. Mammi had predicted that the French and British would come to India by sea route in the 17th century and that the British would end Mughal rule.

Mammi says he had said that holyman with non-violence would achieve independence for India and that three stars (meaning China) would attack India. Also, when he predicted the queen would rule over India, he meant the long rule of Indira Gandhi, Mammi adds.

K G Kanar, advocate and a representative of Amnesty International said that best proof of Mammi's all predictions having become true is Kurch. Kanar said that Mammi had predicted that Mammi, which was once a big international trading port with flags of 84 countries flying here, would lose its glory and Sarva (present day Kandla) which was nothing but a vast expanse of marshy land, would become a thriving port.

Kanar said this had happened in their life-time. He said so much was Mammi revered in the princely state of Kurch that no new king enthroned without blessing from Mammi's descendants.

In the post-independence Kurch, even prince Pragmaji, who declared himself the next king a decade ago, also had the ritual performed at the hand of Mammi's descendant, said Kanar.
